- > All members and guests are asked to **register** in the registration binder as it is passed in from the outside aisle. These will be collected at the end of the service. Please be sure to fill in first and last name.
- > If you are in need of a **nursery**, we have two available in the Preschool Education wing. There is an unattended nursery for mothers with infants in room 104 and an attended nursery for children ages 2 and under in room 111. We ask that you respect these age limits. Please see an usher if you need help locating the nursery. The nursery has a pager system so you can feel comfortable leaving your child knowing they can get in touch with you if there is a problem.
- > **Children's Worship** meets every Sunday of the month except the first one. It is for ages 3 through Kindergarten. Children will be dismissed from the worship service during the song before the sermon to attend Children's Worship. Parents may exit during the closing song to pick them up. LIFE GROUP STUDIES - WINTER, 2017 NAMES GOD CALLS HIMSELF “JEHOVAH-M’KADDESH”

TEXT: LEVITICUS 20:7-8

INTRODUCTION: As we continue our series this morning, the name Jehovah-M'Kaddesh is translated “the Lord who makes us holy.” This word is so very appropriate because one of the essential attributes of God is His holiness. Everything about God is holy. His love is holy, His grace is holy, and even His wrath is Holy. If that is true then a holy God demands a holy people. Today “holy” has become a label to avoid. No one wants to be called a holy roller, or a “holier than thou” person. But the fact is that God desires a people who are holier than anyone else. So the challenge is to see ourselves as holy people. But what are the implications of such a concept? Notice these points about holiness.

1. Holiness is positional
2. Holiness is progressive.
3. Holiness is practical.

QUESTIONS TO CONSIDER

1. What are some things in our world you consider “holy”?
2. What does the word “holy” convey to your mind?
3. Why does the world have such an aversion to the concept of holiness?
4. Read 1 Peter 1:15-16 and Hebrews 12:14. what do these verses tell us about the relationship between holiness and Christians?
5. What does it mean to be “set apart” as the name “holy” implies?
6. How can we develop the mindset that living a holy life is a privilege and not a burden?
