LIFE GROUP STUDIES—FALL, 2016 "SELF-CONTROL WHEN IT FEELS UNNATURAL" SERIES: TIME TO GROW

TEXT: Galatians 5:21-25; Genesis 4

INTRODUCTION: Today we are going to cover the last of the fruit of the Spirit. Some are probably exhaling a sigh of relief. "Finally, we are done with this!" It has been a lengthy series, but I hope that you and I are different than when we started this series: that you find yourself relying on the Holy Spirit more so than doing things in your own power. The final attribute in this list is self-control. Have you ever wondered why this is the last in the list? I don't think it is without purpose that love is the first one listed, but why is self-control the last? Consider this possibility. Self-control is listed last because it takes a resolve and it takes denial of self to overcome any temptation so that you can show love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, and gentleness.

- 3. In what ways did Cain exhibit a lack of self-control?
