- > All members and guests are asked to **register** in the registration binder as it is passed in from the outside aisle. These will be collected at the end of the service. Please be sure to fill in first and last name.
- > If you are in need of a **nursery**, we have two available in the Preschool Education wing. There is an unattended nursery for mothers with infants in room 104 and an attended nursery for children ages 2 and under in room 111. We ask that you respect these age limits. Please see an usher if you need help locating the nursery. The nursery has a pager system so you can feel comfortable leaving your child knowing they can get in touch with you if there is a problem.
- > **Children's Worship** meets every Sunday of the month except the first one. It is for ages 3 through Kindergarten. Children will be dismissed from the worship service during the song before the sermon to attend Children's Worship. Parents may exit during the closing song to pick them up. LIFE GROUP STUDIES—WINTER 2017 "NAMES GOD CALLS HIMSELF" ADONAI

TEXT: ACTS 2:36; ISAIAH 6:1-8

INTRODUCTION: One of the many concepts of God that the Bible reveals is the concept of Lordship. The Lordship of Christ is readily seen in passage after passage in the New Testament as well as prophecies in the Old Testament. Yet as pervasive as Lordship is in the Bible, it is a concept that continues to perplex us. We are privileged to live in America with so many freedoms and rights as citizens. But the concept of Lordship excludes both freedom and rights. It is all about submitting to the leading and directing of Jesus Christ. It indicates God's total possession of me and my total submission to Him.

Two concepts are affirmed in the word Adonai.

1. It is as Adonai that we recognize God as our Master.
2. It is as Adonai that we demonstrate our distinctiveness from the world.

QUESTIONS TO CONSIDER:

1. What comes to mind when you hear the word "lord"?
2. How does the Lordship of Christ contribute to our distinctiveness in the world?
3. Read Isaiah 6:1-8. What stands out to you in the description given in this passage?
4. Turn to Deut. 10:17. How does this verse generate hope for the believer?
5. What promise to you has God ever delayed?
6. What command is particularly difficult for you?
